Sunday evening.

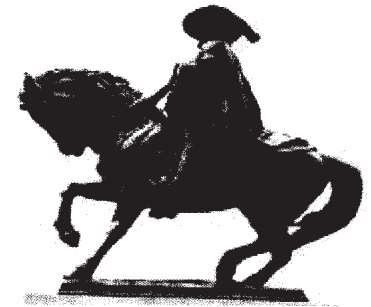

If you are flying into Phoenix, you should arrange with Arizona Shuttle to get from the Phoenix Airport to Tucson at a cost of \$37 one way. The conference van will pick you up at the Shuttle Stop. Call 520-795-6771 to book your space.

Should one elect to drive their car to Tucson, you should plan to park in one of the Airport offsite parking facilities and take their shuttle to the Airport where we will have another van pickup location.

For those of you who want to drive to Nogales, we suggest you may want to park your vehicle in the UETA lot at the end of I-19. Turn right at bottom of hill & enter large lot. They have security. The brunch location is about 1 long block from this lot.

Transportation in and around Magdalena will be by bus provided by the City of Magdalena.
