**WE HAVE ROOMS ON HOLD UNTIL THE 10TH OF FEBRUARY ONLY, SO IT IS IMPERATIVE WE HAVE YOUR RESERVATION BY THAT DATE. Our procedure this year will be a little different in that you will make your room reservation directly with the Society instead of calling the hotel directly.**

We have reserved suites which provide two private bedrooms (1 king & 1 w/2 queens), 2 baths and a lovely kitchen and sitting room which opens up onto a patio. Therefore, it is necessary for us to put together two couples or 1 couple and 1-2 single persons, or 2-4 single persons per suite. You will be paying the hotel directly when you arrive, so you can use your credit card at that time. The rate for a bedroom is \$93.00/night plus 13.05% tax. If space is available, you may be able to book extra nights on either end for that same rate.

*Francisco Xavier Pauer was the Padre who established the mission when Juan Bautista de Anza was Presidio Captain at Tubac. He will tell us what life was like in the mission in the 1700's and what a Mass would have been like.*
